

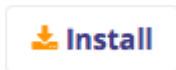
Installation Guide

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Automatic Installation/Eclipse Marketplace

Version 0.4.9



Drag and drop the **Install** button to your running Eclipse workspace (requires the Eclipse Marketplace Client) and follow the installation instructions.

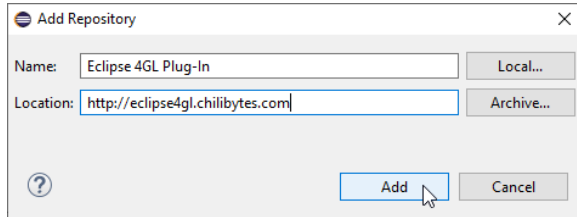
Eclipse Marketplace Install Button

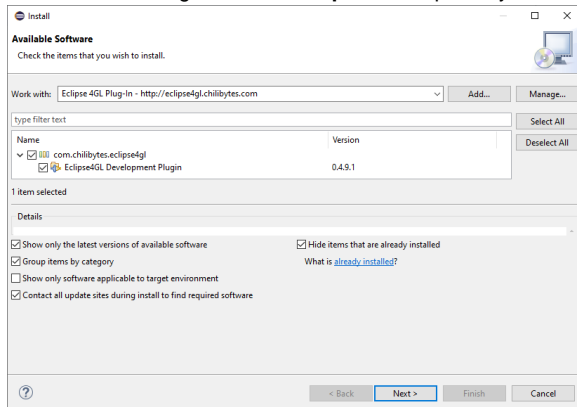
Manual Installation/Eclipse IDE

1. In the **Eclipse IDE** go to **Help > Install New Software...**
2. In the **Install** dialog click on **Add...**
3. In the **Add Repository** dialog enter a name in the **Name** field.

4. In **Location:** add eclipse4gl.chilibytes.com after **http://**



5. Click **OK**.
6. In the **Install** dialog check the **Eclipse4GL** repository.



7. Click **Next**.
8. In the **Install** dialog > **Install Details** review the items to be installed.
9. Click **Next**.
10. In the **Install** dialog > **Review Licenses** review the licenses to be installed.
11. If you agree with the software license agreement, select **I accept the terms of the license agreement**.
12. Click **Finish** to finish software installation.
13. Restart the **Eclipse IDE**.

Updating from an Existing Version

If you plan to update from an existing version, you can also use the software update features in Eclipse:

- In Eclipse select **Help > About Eclipse IDE**.
- Select **Installation Details**.
- In the **Installed Software** tab, select the **Eclipse4GL Plugin**.
- Click **Update...**

- Follow the installation instructions on the screen.



In **Eclipse** you can also use the **Available Software Sites** preference dialog to add software repositories:

1. In **Eclipse** go to **Window > Preferences > Install/Update > Available Software Sites**
2. Click **Add**: to open the **Add Site** dialog to enter the site information.
3. Add name and location.
4. Click **Add**.
